Class Descriptions



Overview

We offer various levels suited for learners ranging from those with no previous experience, to those with significant experience. Each class is 90 minutes for 10 weeks. We also offer an optional FREE instructor led supplemental class every Thursdays from 7:00 – 8:45 PM. We have provided a sample lesson at the end of each description so you can get an idea of an actual lesson that will be covered within each lesson.

Korean Fundamentals (10 Weeks):

Designed for students who have no or very little knowledge of Korean. The goal of this course is to master Korean alphabet (Hangeul) focusing on reading skill including pronunciation rules and to gain basic four skills of Korean (listening, reading, writing, speaking). Korean fundamental will cover four basic topics including greetings, asking jobs and objects, and asking location. Topic marker (은/는), subject marker (이/가), question words (뭐/어느), equational expression (이에요/예요), and 있어요/없어요 will be taught. **Sample Lesson:** [Sample Lesson - K-Fundamentals](#)

Level 1 (10 Weeks):

For students who have completed Korean Fundamental or have the equivalent proficiency. The goal of this course is to master all basic skills focusing on acquire beginner communication skills with vocabulary and basic grammar learning. Korean Level 1 will cover asking basic information such as relationship, phone numbers, birthdays, and expressions of buying things. Numbers (Sino/Native), time marker (~에서 ~까지), question words (얼마나/어떻게), 하다 verbs and adjectives will be taught for 10 weeks in this course. **Sample Lesson:** [Sample Lesson – Level 1](#)

Level 2 (10 Weeks):

For students who have completed Korean Level 1 or have the equivalent proficiency. The goal of this course is to learn how to use all the basic skills of Korean in more complex context focusing on fluency in speaking and writing. Korean Level 2 will cover grammar points about tense (present, past, future tense) and favors. Object marker (을/를), present tense, past tense (왔/였/쓰 어요), and future tense (으)ㄴ 거예요 will be taught for 10 weeks in this course. **Sample Lesson:** [Sample Lesson – Level 2](#)

Level 3 (10 Weeks):

Designed for students who have completed Korean Level 2 or have the equivalent proficiency. The goal of this course is to acquire intermediate communicative skills in all areas with emphasis of writing and intermediate grammar. Korean Level 3 will cover everyday life, appointments, asking directions and ordering food by using proper forms of expressions. Commands with (으)세요, differential expressions (~습니다/버니다) with question (~습니까?/버니까?), and honorific expressions will be taught for 10 weeks in this course. **Sample Lesson:** [Sample Lesson – Level 3](#)

Level 4 (10 Weeks):

For students who have completed Korean Level 3 or have the equivalent proficiency. The goal of this course is to develop intermediate communicative skills in more complex context with emphasis of writing and advanced grammar. Korean Level 4 class will cover public rules, daily conversation in the house, shopping, and living in Korea. Clausal connective (-지만, -(으)ㄴ데/는데, expression desire -고 싶다 and noun-modifying form (Verb~는 + Noun) will be taught for 10 weeks in this course. **Sample Lesson:** [Sample Lesson – Level 4](#)

Level 5 (10 Weeks):

For students who have completed Korean Level 4 or have the equivalent proficiency. The goal of this course is to develop advanced communicative skills in more complex context with emphasis of writing and advanced grammar.
